THE NATIVITY OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST MASS DURING THE DAY
Acts 13:22-26 Who's the Best?

You set goals for yourself. With some of them, you want to improve. You want to be a better student, athlete, poet, or gardener than you were a year ago. But other goals are higher. You want to be the best. You want to know one corner of research better than anyone else. You want your kids to excel beyond their peers. You want to love the best. Some people achieve the best. Others approach them for advice. They dispense wisdom. They win the adulation of everyone, and they are talked about with admiration. John the Baptist must have been like that. He was a tremendous preacher. He gained a strong following of disciples. He challenged people to repentance. They came to him for baptism. John was the best in the eyes of everyone—except his own. John the Baptist knew that no matter what he accomplished, there was one who was greater than he. John was not the Messiah, but he prepared the way. According to Acts of the Apostles, John would say, "What do you suppose that I am? I am not he. Behold, one is coming after me; I am not worthy to unfasten the sandals of his feet."
