# Retiro para Hombres - Discípulos conforme al corazón de Jesús

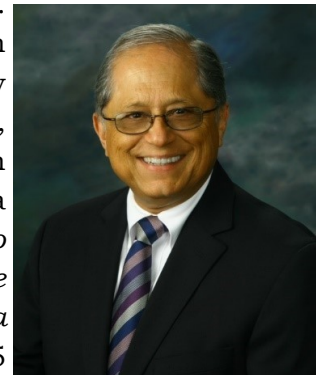


**¿Alguna vez te has preguntado qué significa realmente seguir a Jesús?**
