

## Campfire Salvation – From Darkness to Light!

A big part of the Easter Vigil Mass is the readings that take us from the story of creation to Salvation! Usually our Easter Vigil Celebration begins in a dark church. This Saturday, gather around a campfire to share the readings. Start with a very low fire and add a log after each reading, slowly building up the fire. As the scripture stories bring us closer to Jesus, the Light of the World, the fire will also grow brighter!

This could also be done inside, without the campfire. Start with all the lights in the house off. Then light a candle, turn on a small lamp, or nightlight after each reading.

### **The Readings**

Genesis 1:1, 26-31

Genesis 22:1-18

### **Exodus 14:15-15:1**

Isaiah 54:5-14

Isaiah 55: 1-11

Baruch 3:9-15, 32-4:4

Ezekiel 36:16-28

\*The Gloria is sung! - Salvation is at Hand!

### **Romans 6:3-11**

\*Alleluia is sung!

### **Matthew 28:1-10**

\*Ring some bells and joyfully sing or exclaim the Gloria and Alleluia! Remember we have fasted from these two songs during all of Lent. Joyfully exclaim them while ringing in the Easter season! Our fasting is over, now is the time for feasting and celebration!

If you cannot read all the readings, it is suggested that at minimum the readings in bold along with two other Old Testament readings are read.
