Happy Easter! I love the fact that the Church offers us 40 days of Lenten fasting followed by 50 days of Easter feasting. Easter is, primarily, a season of joy and hopefulness. We rejoice in the resurrection of Jesus from the dead and the new life we have won in Christ. We are hopeful that as Jesus rose from the dead so too one day we will inherit the gift of eternal life.

Another way to give...Introducing Vanco Online Giving

We are excited to announce that we have an additional way for you to offer your support to our parish that is easy and very user friendly! Vanco is an online platform that is used by the Diocese of Davenport and several parishes in our Diocese to allow parishioners to schedule their regular tithes/sacrificial gifts. Whether you wish to make a one-time gift or you wish to schedule your weekly or monthly tithing, Vanco will allow you do to so by having funds withdrawn from your bank account or debit/credit card. There is a very small fee associated with these withdrawals that allows Vanco to offer their services without charging the parish an annual fee.

Vanco can be quite useful for those who travel often or for those who go South during the winter, to ensure continued and consistent giving to the parish. Whether you wish to give to the Sunday Collection or to another specific area (Church Maintenance, Local Charities, Annual Diocesan Collections, etc...), all you have to do is click on the tile and enter the requested information. Your donation will be automatically deposited into the parish bank account and sent to be recorded so that it appears on your annual giving statement.

Vanco will not be replacing our existing Auto Tithing program. If you already have recurring donations set up, there is nothing you need to do. In order to access our new Vanco online giving page, all you need to do is visit our parish webpage, www.stmarysosky.com, and click on the "Giving" link at the top of the webpage.
