Parish Family,

When we think of Thanksgiving, we immediately call to mind the annual celebration of Thanksgiving, the annual holiday that marks the safe arrival of our ancestors to the United States of America in the 17th century. We look forward, each year, to the feast of turkey and all of the trimmings shared with loved ones and opportunities to reconnect as families. As Catholics, however, "thanksgiving" takes on a much deeper and more significant meaning.

From the earliest days of Christianity, the Mass has been referred to as the celebration of the Eucharist. Eucharist comes from a Greek word which means "to give thanks."
